

Year 7 2022 Specialised Programs Application Process

Students who live within our school zone (proof of residence is validated as per information below) are invited to apply for a place in any of the specialised programs on offer for Year 7 students in 2022. Our college website will have all relevant answers for prospective students and parents. Please ensure you regularly check for any updates.

Please note the following:

1. The following programs: Athlete Development Program and Musician Development Program are run **in addition to the standard Year 7 program and is only open to applicants who live within our school zone.**
Note: MDP applications will be open from late August/early September 2021
2. **The SEAL program is a standalone program** with a different curriculum to the standard Year 7 program **and is only open to applicants who live within our school zone.**
3. Applicants to the SEAL program are also eligible to apply for any of the other specialised programs (Athlete Development Program or Musician Development Program) if they wish.

All students wishing to apply for entry in any of the specialised programs will need to be aware of the following information:

- Enrolments are provided to students within our School Zone as set out by the Department of Education and Training. We foresee that students within our school zone or with older siblings enrolled for 2022 will most likely bring the school to full capacity in Year 7 for 2022. **This applies to all students, including those wishing to apply for special curriculum programs (SEAL, ADP, MDP)**

The following stages of application should be noted:

1. Applicants to any program must complete the online application form and provide the following documentation and submit it to Kambrya College, attention Mrs Rose Serra; **no later than May 7th, 2021.**

SEAL Applications require:

- a. Online Expression of Interest form to be completed.
***Proof of Residence validation as per the EOI form to be emailed to: Rosetta.Serra@education.vic.gov.au
Please **do not** submit written references.
- b. Applicants to the SEAL Program note there is also an Edutest online registration component and fee that needs to be completed and paid **by April 30th, 2021** *failure to complete Edutest online registration and fee on time, will result in your child not being able to sit the SEAL exam for our college.*

ADP Applications require:

- a. Online Expression of Interest form to be completed.

- b. Online ADP Application Profile form to be completed.
Provide relevant references from sporting coaches. **Maximum of 2** references in total to be supplied.

MDP Applications require:

Online Expression of Interest form will be available on our website: <http://www.kambryacollege.com/year7-transition/> from late August/early September 2021. Students accepted into our college for Year 7 2022 are welcome to apply for this program through this process.

2. Applicants for SEAL and ADP programs will be shortlisted as part of the Application Process (please refer to the Special Program flyers for further details). The shortlisted applicants for SEAL and ADP will be required to attend an interview, note SEAL applicant interviews will be held as group interviews on **Thursday 10th June 2021**. Shortlisted Applicants to the ADP will be required to also attend a tryout on **Tuesday 8th June 2021**. Emails will be sent to all shortlisted applicants of their interview and/or tryout times at the earliest convenience. Please do not contact the college until you have been notified by email.
3. Applicants not successful at shortlist stage will be notified via email. College decisions are final.
4. Testing for SEAL is held at Kambrya College on **Saturday 8th May 2021**. See SEAL application process for additional information.
5. Shortlisted Applicants for SEAL and ADP will be notified if they are successful or unsuccessful in obtaining a place in a Special Program via email or post **on Thursday 5th August 2021** – following DET guidelines. College decisions are final. Only those living within the school zone with valid proof of residence documentation will be accepted.
6. Successful applicants for SEAL and ADP will be required to return their Yr. 7 Special Program Acceptance Form by **27th August 2021 by 4pm** and change their Application for Year 7 Placement form (through child's Primary School) to identify Kambrya College as their first preference (if applicable). Your child's place will not be kept if we do not receive the acceptance form by the due date.
7. Successful applicants who decline their offer will be removed from the program and their place will be taken up by another student where applicable.
8. **Late Applications for SEAL and ADP programs will not be accepted.**

Please note that the application process, may change at any stage. Should we be required to make changes our college website will have relevant information for all parents. We encourage parents to check our website regularly for any updates.
