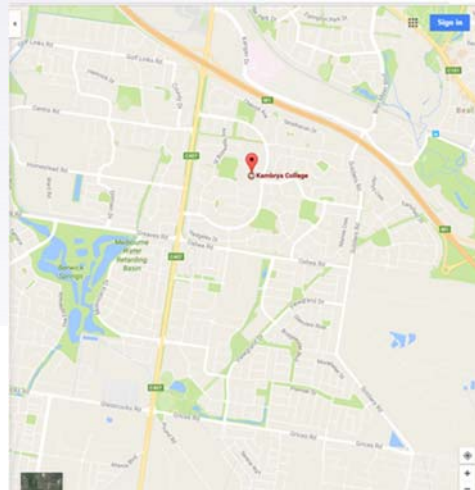

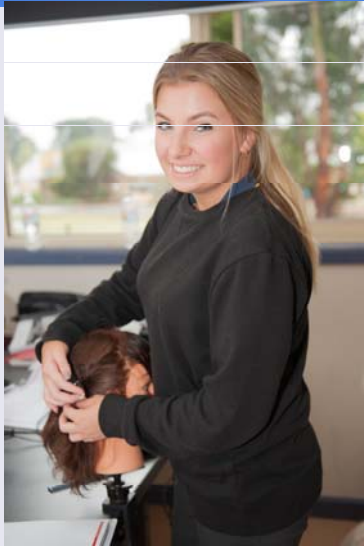

### VET Hairdressing

This course aims to provide participants with the knowledge and skills that will enhance their employment prospects in the hairdressing or hairdressing related industries. Students can undertake this course whilst completing their VCE or VCAL classes. Students will learn how to blow wave, set hair, create braiding, apply colours, complete financial transactions and provide great customer service.

### Course Code and Title:

**SHB20216:** Certificate II in Salon Assistant

**Class Times:** Wednesday 9.00—2.30pm

### Uniform Requirements:

Black Salon Tunic will be provided.

Students are to wear all black clothing (no leggings, short skirts or shoe string straps) and closed toed black shoes (no runners).

Teachers will advise students of the code of conduct on induction day.

### Contribution to VCE/VCAL

**VCE Credit:** Credit is awarded in the VCE on the basis of achieving units of competency. Credit is determined by the AQF level and the nominal hours of the units of competency.

**This program does NOT provide a Units 3 and 4 sequence.**

**VCAL Credit:** This program meets the requirements of the Industry Specific stream for both Intermediate and Senior VCAL.

Completion of this course may enable you to undertake an Apprenticeship and progress to the Certificate III in Hairdressing. On completion of the Certificate III you will be eligible for employment at an entry level in the field of hairdressing.
